3 Castas Blanco Arinto, Chardonnay, Fernão Pires

TEJO, PORTUGAL, 2022 (V)

Bright and citrusy wine showing the unbeatable value Portugal can offer. Grapefruit and lemon pith with light almond on the finish.

Sauvignon Grenache Blanc 'Les Terrasses', Vignerons Ardéchois

ARDÈCHE, FRANCE, 2022 (V)

A well-balanced wine with lots of charm. A nose with lime, melon and herbs before a crisp palate of lemon, cut grass and mint.

Garganega, Cantina Negrar

VENETO, ITALY, 2022 (V)

From the noble grape that produces Soave in Italy, this offers a gorgeous nose of pear and almond, with melon and peach on the palate.

Pinot Grigio 'Loggia Dei Colli', Piera Martellozzo

VENEZIE, ITALY, 2022

An elegant Pinot Grigio with subtle fruits of apple and pear with hints of orange blossom. A light refreshing body and crisp finish make this wine very enjoyable.

Picpoul de Pinet, Malassagne

PICPOUL DE PINET, FRANCE, 2022

Elegant aromas of citrus, pear and herbs with a crisp mineral palate that is ideally suited to seafood.

Chenin Blanc Unwooded, Delheim

STELLENBOSCH, S AFRICA, 2023 (V)

Packed with aromas of white and yellow peaches, guava and pineapple. A very crisp and zesty wine that is a great stylistic alternative to Sauvignon Blanc. The fresh acidity and abundance of clean fruit flavours lead to a well-balanced palate.

Chardonnay, Domaine du Cléray

LOIRE, FRANCE, 2022 (V)

A dead ringer for Chablis, this wine comes from a small property in the cool Loire valley. Oyster shell and crisp green apple, a complex and refreshing wine.

Pecorino, Vigneti Radica

ABRUZZO, ITALY, 2022

Abruzzo, with its high mountains running down to the sea, is an excellent place to make crisp white wines. Pecorino thrives here and gives good flavour and a pleasing waxy texture. Notes of citrus and exotic fruits and a whiff of mountain flowers.

Grüner Veltliner, Klosterneuburg

WAGRAM, AUSTRIA, 2022 (V)

Made by Austria's oldest winery from their own vineyards located on both terraces and steeply sloping ground. Classic slightly spicy aroma of citrus, green apples and white pepper with a crisp structure.

Sauvignon Blanc, Hunter's

MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND, 2023 (V)

Classically Marlborough, this wine immediately shows a mixture of herbaceous capsicum, passion fruit and ripe tropical fruit aromas. It has a very refreshing multi-layered palate. A multi award-winning wine that is surely one the best coming out of New Zealand.

Mâcon La Roche-Vineuse Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Normand

BURGUNDY, FRANCE, 2022

Taken from their oldest vineyard parcels and given the full Burgundy treatment with fermentation and aging in oak. Rich and creamy but still retains freshness, a long lingering length.

SPARKLING

Prosecco Spumante, Lamberti

VENETO, ITALY, NV

Pale straw in colour with fine and persistent bubbles. On the nose it is clean with light-green apple aromas. On the palate it has an appealing flavour of green apple and lemon with natural fruitiness and a pleasant aromatic aftertaste.

Crémant d'Alsace 'Cuvée Prestige' Brut, Arthur Metz

ALSACE, FRANCE, NV

Made in the traditional method but using the unique grapes of Alsace, this wine has beautiful fine bubbles and notes of peach, apple tart and brioche.

Champagne Baron Albert 'l'Universelle' Brut

CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE, NV (V)

A family owned champagne house run by three sisters who each run a separate strand of the business. This cuvée contains a large percentage of Pinot Meunier giving an approachable wine with strawberry leaf and citrus aromas.

Joseph Perrier 'Cuvée Royale' Brut

CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE, NV (V)

A remarkable and noble champagne house still under family ownership. Fresh fruity aromas such as pear and red apple lead to richer fresh bread notes and a touch of biscuit. The wine is aged for a minimum of three years in their cellars giving complexity and sophistication.

RED

3 Castas Tinto (Touriga Nacional, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon), Fiuza

TEJO, PORTUGAL, 2022 (V)

Full of local character, the wine opens with notes of cherry, liquorice and blossom. The palate has a medium body and is crammed full of fruits of the forrest, clove and bark.

Merlot Syrah 'Les Terrasses', Vignerons Ardéchois

ARDÈCHE, FRANCE, 2022 (V)

A cracking wine full of southern French charm. Mint, bramble and a touch of cocoa dance round the palate. An easy-drinking charmer.

Corvina, Cantina Negrar

VENETO, ITALY, 2021 (V)

A charming wine with spicy notes of vanilla and hints of cherry and black grape. It offers soft sweet tannins and a pleasing finish with spicy tones.

Malbec 'Punto Final' Renacer

MENDOZA, ARGENTINA, 2023 (V)

Elegant floral tones of violet and rose combined with red fruits such as blackcurrant and raspberry. Subtle notes of vanilla from the passing contact with oak. On the palate, the wine is smooth and silky with round tannins and a long persistent finish. A very elegant Malbec.

Rioja Crianza, Valdepalacios

RIOJA, SPAIN, 2020 (V)

The wine occupies a sweet spot where oak and fruit mix together and complement each other perfectly. Complex and intense aromas with cocoa and mulberry notes.

Pinot Noir 'Les Buis d'Als', Vignerons Ardéchois

ARDÈCHE, FRANCE, 2022 (V)

An outstanding Pinot Noir that could compete with many red Burgundys! Ripe cherry, blueberry, toast and spice lead the nose, leading to a structured palate combining fruit, spice and subtle notes of sous bois and oak. A long finish that is fresh and stony with an echo of the bright fruit. An outstanding value wine.

Heilan Coo, Shiraz Mataro

VICTORIA, AUSTRALIA, 2022 (V)

Celebrating the iconic Highland cow, which is as admired in Australia as it is here for its gentle nature and high-quality beef. A well-bred wine dripping with plum and chocolate flavours. The Mataro adds a depth and subtle spice notes.

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 'Patch', Cantina Orsogna

ABRUZZO, ITALY, 2021 (V)

Spicy italian red from the gorgeous rolling hills of Abruzzo. Pepper, blueberry and damson notes.

Petite Laurence, Château Laurence

BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR, FRANCE, 2016

Although only the second wine of the estate, this is serious stuff and amazing value. With great endorsement from the owner of Angelus, who should know a thing or two about Merlot, this is a structured, savoury merlot drinking beautifully.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Delheim

STELLENBOSCH, S AFRICA, 2019

Aromas of cassis, plum, cedar wood and cigar box with a slight herbaceous undertone. The palate is well structured with fine and delicate tannins and beautiful oak integration. Cassis flavours linger on the finish.

Gigondas 'Romane Machotte', Amadieu

RHÔNE, FRANCE, 2020 (V)

Flavours of black and red cherries are enveloped in soft-yet-powerful tannins, mingling with scents of Provençal herbs. Long and spicy finish seasoned with black pepper.

ROSÉ

Malbec Rosé 'Punto Final', Renacer

MENDOZA, ARGENTINA, 2022, (V)

The famous terroir in Argentina also allows them to produce delicious rosé from their signature Malbec grape. Early harvested to retain bright fruity notes of cherry and damson.

Semillon 'Macerao' Orange Wine, LFE

COLCHAGUA VALLEY, CHILE, 2021 (V)

Chile has amazing vineyards beyond what most people know. Old vines in the south are the source for this orange wine, which is where white grapes are left in contact with the wine for an extended period.

Charmeur Rosé, Château Sainte Croix

PROVENCE, FRANCE, 2022

The top cuvée from this domaine. Beautifully dry and elegant, with notes of strawberry, cherry and raspberry.

PUDDING

Six Grapes Port, Graham's

DOURO, PORTUGAL

Dark red colour, with a seductive rich perfume of ripe plums and cherries. On the palate, Ripe and full with sweet fruit flavours. Grahams oldest marquee which denoted the best barrels in the Quinta. This is in fact a young vintage port, giving surprising depth and length.

Pedro Ximénez Single Bota-Aged 5 years, Diatomists

JEREZ, SPAIN, NV

The nose is packed with figs, dark chocolate, roasted coffee and cigar box aromas. Very smooth and balanced on the palate without cloying sweetness, this is an elegant PX aged for 5 years in bota. Extremely concentrated and nuanced, an ethereal wine with invigorating acidity. The finish is endless with a hint of nutmeg and cloves.

Jurançon Doux 'Pas de Deux', Domaine Nigri

JURANÇON, FRANCE, 2020

Honey, lemon peel, candied fruits, orange blossom and citrus notes; all balanced with a lengthy finish. An aromatic and individual wine the sort of which you find nowhere else.
